A Private Pilot License Program in Delta, BC will allow you to fly almost anywhere, with passengers, in a Canadian-registered aircraft. Private Pilot License could be enhanced with additional ratings to allow the holder to fly sea planes or multi-engine aircraft as well as flight in any weather condition day or night. It acts as a foundation upon which such ratings can be added. Private Pilot License is required by all students enrolling in a Commercial Pilot License.



Training Overview of Private Pilot License Program

The Private Pilot License program is divided into Ground school and Flight Training. Ground school will furnish you with the required background knowledge and understanding to successfully challenge the Transport Canada written examination, while the air instruction and solo practice will provide you with the skills required to succeed at the flight test.

Flight Training

Flight training is separated into dual instruction and solo practice. A minimum of 40 hours of flight training required.

Note for the Private Pilot License Program at Insignia College, rates are the same for domestic and international students. Flight Training cost is based on Transport Canada Minimum on the Cessna 172 Skyhawk Plane. If any student exceeds these requirements due to their performance, the student will pay extra for any additional training. Any additional training will be charged at the same hourly rates as mentioned above. Pricing is subject to change. Fuel surcharges will apply on top of these hourly rates. Taxes are applied where applicable. Administration fees will be applicable upon registration.

○ Duration of Private Pilot License Program

Training is at the student's pace and convenience and can start any time. On average students take up to 10 to 12 months to complete a PPL (2-3 lessons a week). The pace and scheduling of the Private Pilot License Program at Insignia College in Delta, BC is up to the student.
